Formal didactic conferences occur biweekly at Doctors Hospital and Grant Medical Center. These include Morbidity and Mortality Conference, Tumor Board, Grand Rounds, anatomy courses, and board review sessions. Residents participate in seminars presented by Ohio University Heritage College of Medicine regarding Practice Management, Professionalism, and more. General Surgery residents also have extensive exposure to simulation training, which includes work with the Laparoscopic Mentor, Vascular Mentor, Angiography Mentor, and DaVinci Robot. Residents also work through online modules aimed to further knowledge including the American Medical Association curriculum and the Surgical Council on Resident Education. Doctors Hospital also offers a wealth of additional outstanding continuing medical education programs that residents are welcome to attend at no charge as time and interest permits.
