\*The Eagala Model is the global standard for equine-assisted psychotherapy and personal development, which incorporates horses' unique intuition to help clients heal, discover, learn, and grow from the horse-human relationship. Participants work with horses in a non-riding setting that helps them build skills and supports their mental health goals in a group environment.


